Brad Bernard

Coach Bernard is entering his 10th season as Offensive Coordinator at Bethune-Cookman University in Daytona Beach Florida. Under his leadership the Tigers led the MEAC in almost all statistical categories. His 2006 offensive team rushed for a league high 316 yards per game while throwing for another 200 yards in the air. Coach Bernard approaches coaching in the same manner he approached playing at Georgia Southern, where as a player and a coach, Brad helped Georgia Southern to four bowl subdivision national championships. Coach Bernard also coached at Sandalwood and Mandarin High Schools before leading Raines H.S. to the Florida 4A state title in 1997

Nathan Cochran

Cochran is the Head Football coach at Lincoln University in Missouri; Cochran most recently served as Assistant Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator for Blackburn College in Carlinville, Illinois. At Blackburn Cochran's offense broke over 30 team and individual school records, achieving a ranking of 9th in the country for NCAA Division III rushing. Prior to Blackburn, Coach Cochran coached at University of Wisconsin Platteville, Allen University, and South Carolina State University where he was a player.

Joe Dupaix

Coach Dupaix is entering his 2nd season at the United States Naval Academy where he coaches "A" backs and special teams. Prior to his current position at Navy, Joe served as the Offensive Coordinator at Cal-Poly where he directed the Mustang option attack that averaged 487 yards and 39.3 points per game. Joe also coached at Riverton High School UT, and University of Missouri-Rolla. As a Quarterback at Southern Utah he set the bowl subdivision record rushing yards by a Quarterback in 1996 while leading SUU.

Troy Everhart

Troy Everhart is the Head Football Coach at Winton Woods High School in Cincinnati, Ohio. Previously Everhart coached at Oak Hills, Withrow, and Batavia High Schools in Ohio, and an assistant at Ohio Northern and a Graduate Assistant at the University of Cincinnati. During his tenure as Head Football Coach at Winton Woods High School, he has led the Warriors to four league titles in the past eight seasons and four straight playoff berths. Coach Everhart was the 2006, Cincinnati Coach of the Year as named by the Marvin Lewis Foundation.

Dan Higgins

Higgins is the Assistant Coach at Coco Beach High School in Florida, previously he was an assistant football coach under Paul Johnson at Navy. Prior to nave he was the head football coach at Eau Gallie High School in Melbourne, Fla., where he received numerous awards as District 5A and 6A coach of the year. Other Florida high school stints included West Nassau H.S., Choctawhatchee H.S., Fernandina Beach H. S., and at Camden County High School in St. Mary's, Ga. Coach Higgins' College experience includes stints at Auburn, Georgia Southern, Hawai'i, Valparaiso, and Lee's McRae College.

C. Ray Gregory

Coach Gregory is the "A" back coach at Bethune-Cookman University. A respected speaker and author coach Gregory is best known as the Head Coach at Southern Utah University where his teams were the bowl subdivision leader in rushing. Two quarterbacks Joe Dupaix and Matt Cannon went on to set NCAA records for rushing by a quarterback. In 2000 the T-Birds averaged 394 yards rushing, 481 total yards and 35.9 points per game, and in 2000 and 2001 his teams finished in the top 25 in Division 1AA. Coach Gregory has experience at Abington High School in Virginia and Morton High School in Illinois. His collegiate experience includes: Bridgewater State, Georgia Southern, Hawaii, Itawamba, College, Lees McRae, and University at Buffalo, Hinds and Millsap's College.

Chris Howard

Is the Head Coach at Lawrence University in Appleton Wisconsin, where he has evolved the vaunted Spread Option attack he utilized at Granger High School and Southern Utah University to a formidable gun and pistol option attack. Always an innovator, Coach Howard, has prolific experience on both sides of the ball. Prior to Lawrence coach Howard served as the defensive coordinator at St. Norbert's College. At Southern Utah he produced a statistical leading offensive unit and then took over the defense and helped lead the T-birds to national ranking in the Bowl Sub-division. Coach Howard coaching career also included stints as a graduate assistant at Illinois State, Southern Illinois University, and University of Utah

Bill Mack

Bill Mack is regarded as the "Dean" of flexbone football in Illinois. In 26 years as a high school football coach, including two decades in Crystal Lake, Illinois, Mack guided teams to 154 wins and 5 ties while losing only 71 games. In 1987, he became the youngest active coach to be elected to the Illinois Football Coaches Hall of Fame. Coach Mack has installed his heralded option attack at Beloit College, Trinity International University, Wheaton College, North Central College as the Head football Coach, Carmel High School, Lake Forest College, and Elmhurst College. He currently serves as the Assistant Head Coach at Prairie Ridge High School.
