## CLINICIAN PROFILES

**RICK STREIFF**, Cathedral High School, Indianapolis, IN: Rick's first coaching assignment was as a graduate assistant at Butler under Bill Sylvester and in 1985 accepted a teaching and coaching at Bishop Chatard HS in Indianapolis. Rick served as wide receiver and line-backer coach as well as Head JV coach. In 1987, he assumed the role of offensive coordinator at Bishop Chatard. In 1988, Rick became the Head Coach at Brebeuf Preparatory School and in 1989 took over the same position at Indianapolis Cathedral High School. From 1989-2001, Rick led Cathedral to four State Championships and one runner-up. In 2002, he became the Head Coach of North Central High School and helped to resurrect the program, leaving in the 2005 season with a 7-4 record in the very tough MIC Conference. Out of coaching from 2006 - 2007, Rick returned to Cathedral to lead them to State Championships in 2008 and 2010. Cathedral is the all time win leader in the state of Indiana with 658 wins. Record at Cathedral HS is 156-34. Overall record 179-77.

**RICK FINOTTI**, St. Edward High School, Lakewood, OH: Rick Finotti, St. Edward High School, Lakewood, Ohio: Nominated as the 2010 State of Ohio Coach of the Year. The 2010 St. Edward Eagles won the school's first ever Ohio State Football Championship, finished Nationally #2 in the Rivals.com Rankings, #13 in the USA Today Super 25 Rankings, and #11 in the ESPN National Poll. Served as an assistant coach at the high school level with Villa Angela-St. Joseph High School, Benedictine High School, and Mayfield High School where most recently Finotti was the Defensive Coordinator. At Mayfield High School, Finotti led one of the state's top defenses as the team's defensive coordinator from 2005-2008. At Mayfield, Finotti coached 11 all-state players, including an "All-Ohio Defensive Player of the Year," and in 2008 he was awarded the Assistant Coach of the Year-Region III by the Ohio High School Coaches Association. Before coaching at Mayfield, Finotti was an assistant coach at Benedictine, and was part of the staff that won the 2004 Ohio Division III State Championship.
